We take unwanted bicycles, and recycle them. We build them into usable bikes again. or We strip them down to parts, evaluate and renovate if necessary, but most importantly, we keep bikes out of the landfill. In 2022 we saved 1500 bikes from Landfill

When you bring a bicycle to CycleRecycle for donation we will give you a £5 voucher to spend in-store. (Please note we are unable to collect)

You don't need to contact us to donate your unwanted bikes, just bring your bikes along to the store and we will do the rest (Sadly we do not collect unwanted bicycles)
